2025-2026 New TK/K Registration Information

January 24, 2025

Dear Parent/Guardian of Transitional Kindergarteners (TK) or Kindergarten (K) student:

The 2025-2026 school year is just around the corner. Please see the information below:

- A. **FUTURE KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:** If your child is currently attending TK at your neighborhood/home school and you want your child to continue in your neighborhood/home school for kindergarten in 2025-2026, you do not need to complete a new student registration. Your child will automatically move up to kindergarten at your neighborhood/home school, and the Continuing Student Enrollment form must be completed starting May 27, 2025.
- B. **FUTURE KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:** If your child is currently attending TK at a school that is NOT your neighborhood school, and you want him/her to attend Kindergarten at your neighborhood/home school in 2025-2026, you must complete a new student enrollment online. Please contact your neighborhood/home school office for further details, especially if you are interested in the Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Program.
- C. **FUTURE TK STUDENTS:** You must complete a new student enrollment online for your school of residence.
- D. **FUTURE TK STUDENTS:** If you want your TK student to attend another school site, specifically if you are interested in another program like Dual Language Immersion (DLI), you must first enroll at your school of residence *and then complete a new Zone Transfer (ZT) Application*. Please contact your neighborhood/home school office for further details.

The 2025-2026 school year enrollment begins **February 12, 2025, at 9 am**. To register your child, please visit our website at www.cvesd.org and click on "Enroll Now." You will need your child's birth certificate, updated immunization record, one current proof of residency, and your photo identification ready to upload during the process. Several of our schools have Impacted Programs, which means that these sites will have an enrollment process that is lottery-based, where a random enrollment process will be used to assign students to programs through a lottery system to ensure fairness and equal opportunity. The process occurs at schools when the number of applicants exceeds available spots, and assignments are made at random.
